

CODE OF CONDUCT

Members of Valverde Bowls Club are required to show respect and consideration to other members and to visitors, both at Valverde and in away matches, to ensure that we sustain a friendly atmosphere and the good name of the club.

To be specific, the following behaviour is considered unacceptable:

- Verbal abuse of other bowlers, whether or not related
- Arguing and shouting aggressively
- Showing a lack of respect to visitors
- Refusing to shake hands before or after a game
- Indulging in gamesmanship on the green, to gain advantage over an opponent
- Showing an aggressive or confrontational attitude to fellow bowlers
- Behaving generally in an unpleasant or antisocial manner, to the detriment of other bowlers
- Persistent failure by PAYP members in their responsibility to offer payment of green fees
- Ignoring the club Dress Code

Members breaching the code may be warned by the Management Committee and subject to further disciplinary action.
