Rink allocation principles

1. From mid September to mid May, known as the winter season, when the club is under pressure from member numbers, roll up mornings Mondays, Wednesday and Fridays are ring fenced.

The exceptions to this are

- a) Visiting tour teams which will have first priority, these are usually March/April and September/October although we try to limit their incursions into roll up space, but these matches are an important contribution to club finances, and we have very limited ability to negotiate match date and times.
- b) Special club events e.g. the Anniversary Pairs, Spring Pairs, if scheduled for a roll up morning, will have second priority for rink allocation. These events again contribute towards club finances and, we would expect most club members to participate in the event.

Club members wishing to book rinks are advised to make use of afternoons, evenings and weekends which are generally free. The exceptions to this are Tuesday mornings for maintenance, Wednesday afternoon Australian Pairs League, and any interclub league matches, all of which will be on the CLUB DIARY.

At all times members must book their rink requirements in the RINK DIARY. This is to ensure that our greensman, Nick, can prepare and have the necessary equipment available

2. From mid May to mid September, known as the summer season, when member numbers are generally much reduced, and the afternoon temperatures are uncomfortable, two rinks can be made available on a roll up morning for any other arranged match e.g. Summer Singles. The same booking rules must apply.
